	BULB TYPE	PROPER DISPOSAL
	<b>Compact Fluorescent Lights (CFL)</b>	CFLs contain mercury and should be disposed/recycled properly. <b>Recycling Options:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Take to Batteries Plus Bulbs, Home Depot or Lowes.</li> <li>Bring to a RRRASOC Household Hazardous Waste event.</li> </ul> <i>Recycling allows the reuse of the glass, metals and other materials that make up fluorescent lights. Virtually all components of a fluorescent bulb can be recycled.</i>
	<b>Fluorescent Tubes</b>	Fluorescent tubes contain mercury and should be disposed/recycled properly. <b>Recycling Options:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Take to Batteries Plus Bulbs, Home Depot or Lowes.</li> <li>Bring to a RRRASOC Household Hazardous Waste event.</li> </ul> <i>Recycling CFLs and other fluorescent bulbs allows the reuse of the glass, metals and other materials that make up fluorescent lights. Virtually all components of a fluorescent bulb can be recycled.</i>
	<b>Halogen</b>	Halogen bulbs can be disposed with regular household trash. <i>A halogen light bulb uses a tungsten filament just like an incandescent light bulb but also contains halogen gas which an incandescent bulb does not.</i>
	<b>High Intensity Discharge (HID) Mercury Vapor, Metal Halide, High Pressure Sodium</b>	High Intensity Discharge bulbs contain mercury and should be disposed/recycled properly. <b>Recycling Options:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Take to Batteries Plus Bulbs.</li> <li>Bring to a RRRASOC Household Hazardous Waste event.</li> </ul>
	<b>Incandescent</b>	Can be disposed with regular household garbage.
	<b>LED</b>	Can be disposed with regular household garbage. <i>LEDs DO NOT contain dangerous chemicals.</i>
