7 Benefits of Recycling

Did you know?

- Recycling creates nine jobs for every ton of material recycled, while only one job is created if that same ton is landfilled.
- 2. Using recycled paper instead of virgin materials reduces air pollution by 74% and water pollution by 35%.
- 3. Using recycled aluminum instead of virgin ore reduces air pollution by 95% and water pollution by 97%.
- 4. Using recycled iron and steel cuts air pollution by 86%, water pollution by 76%, and mining wastes by 97%.
- 5. For every ton of paper you recycle, you save 17 trees, 464 gallons of oil, 42 gallons of gasoline, and 7,000 gallons of water.
- 6. Recycling one glass bottle saves enough energy to light a 100 watt light bulb for four hours
- 7. Recycling one tin can saves enough energy to run a television for three hours.

Monday, Wednesday and Friday – 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Tuesday and Thursday – 9:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.

HHW pickup from your home is also available for a fee of \$135 per stop plus \$0.75 per pound of material collected. This fee is paid directly by the resident to ERG Environmental Services.
