happy to partner with Simple Recycling to provide residents with a free, safe way to bring new life to unwanted clothing and household goods as an effective way to protect people and the environment. There are a few program improvements to note:

- Residents no longer have to wait for their scheduled recycle day. Schedule a pickup that is convenient for you online at RRRASOC.org, SimpleRecycling.com, or by calling 866-835-5068
- Residents no longer need to use the dedicated orange Simple Recycling bags for collection - items can be placed in any waterproof bags or boxes marked "Simple Recycling"
- Clearly marked waterproof bags or boxes can be placed on the front porch or in front of the garage door by 7:30 a.m. on the scheduled pickup day

Save time and avoid the line by dropping off HHW at ERG Environmental Services in Livonia on non-event days without a fee during the following hours:

Monday, Wednesday and Friday

9:00 AM – 5:00 PM

Tuesday and Thursday

9:00 AM – 7:00 PM

HHW pickup from your home is also available for a fee of \$135 per stop plus \$0.75 per pound of material collected. This fee is paid directly by the resident to ERG Environmental Services.
