# **Get Ready for HHW Collection Events**



The first of this year's RRRASOC Household Hazardous Waste Collection Events is on April 5 at the Wixom Department of Public Works - *that's right around the corner!* At these special events, residents of Farmington, Farmington Hills, Village of Milford, Milford Township, Novi, Southfield, South Lyon, Walled Lake, and Wixom have an opportunity to safely discard their hazardous items, e-waste, sensitive documents for shredding, batteries, and even clothing for donation.

Need to refresh your knowledge on what's accepted at HHW Collection Events, or just want to familiarize yourself with a few collection and transportation tips to keep everything running smoothly? Check below for some helpful info!

## What's Accepted?



Consider the HHW that's taking up space in your home. Do you still use these items, or can they be disposed of? Check your bathroom, kitchen, garage, and workshop for bleach, cleaners, solvents, aerosol cans, auto oils and fluids, paints, glues, pesticides, and more.

## What Do I Need to Know?



The event starts at 9am. You're welcome to arrive early and wait in the line in your car, but please be aware that HHW will not be collected until the event starts. At that time, workers will unload the HHW from your vehicle to reduce unnecessary foot traffic.



All kinds of electronic waste and batteries are accepted at HHW Collection Events! Feel free to bring car batteries, rechargeable Li-ion batteries, button batteries, and alkaline batteries to the event. Additionally, any item that has a cord (plugs in to the wall) or motherboard is accepted as e-waste.



Some items are easy to miss! Don't forget to bring your propane tanks, oil-based paints, and pill-form medications to the event, as well as clothing to donate and documents for shredding!



While everyone at the event is working hard to keep things running smoothly, hiccups do happen on occasion. Please remember to be patient! To save time for both workers and attendees, place your items in boxes (such as shipping boxes) that you do not need back.



Lightbulbs and batteries need extra care when packing for transport. Try to keep them separate and secured to avoid shattered glass in your trunk. Additionally, please tape the end terminals of your batteries so that they do not touch one another; improper disposal could cause fires!

The answer is: Only if they're empty!

Empty aerosol cans are recyclable at curbside or RRRASOC dropoff locations. Remove plastic lids before recycling them. # **HHW Drop-Off at ERG Environmental Services**

If you have HHW that you'd like to properly dispose of between collection events, you're in luck! Drop off your HHW without a fee at ERG Environmental Services during the following hours:

Monday - Friday: 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM

HHW pickup from your home is also available for a fee of \$135 per stop plus \$0.75 per pound of material collected. This fee is paid directly by the resident to ERG Environmental Services.

Not sure what to do with stuff?


Visit **rrrasoc.org** and use the Recycling Directory search bar to type in keywords and get recycling, composting, reuse or disposal instructions.
